- EPPC
 - The April 20, 2017 EPPC meeting has been canceled.

HS Team:

- SHSP
 - Applicants submitted their 2017 SHSP Projects to the Office of the Governor by the February 28, 2017, deadline. The final project prioritized list was submitted on March 31, 2017. Funds will be awarded September-October, 2017.
- REPAC
 - The next REPAC meeting is May 4, 2017. There will be a guest speaker presenting the Multi-Jurisdiction Improvised Explosive Device Security Planning Workshop Series Program (MJIEDSP).
- UASI
 - The E-Grants portal is now open for everyone to enter their UASI projects. Projects must be entered and certified by your Authorized Official by May 1st.
 - We anticipate grant guidance to be released sometime in May. That is when we will find out our allocation amounts.
- **Public Education**
 - Guidebooks in English were updated and printed 2016 and available for distribution in Dallas. Spanish guidebook are being finalized for print.
 - KnowWhat2Do website redesign: vendor has been selected and will go live July 31, 2017.
 - Promotional items
 - Bandage dispensers, will be ordering more multi-toolkits with KnowWhat2Do web address to promote new website.

- **Interop**
 - A survey regarding radio flash update needs was sent to the Public Safety Communication listserv to assess the needs of the region. Once the survey is complete and the needs are assessed the flash updates will be purchased with FY 16 SHSP funds.
 - The InterOp Working Group in conjunction with the NCTTRAC will be hosting a series of COMML/COMMT courses. Dates will be announced soon once instructors are identified.
 - If you are interested in receiving communications-related information, you can request to be added to the Public Safety Communications listserv (publicsafetycomms@list.ncttrac.org). To have yourself, or a member of your agency added to the listserv, email vhooker@nctcog.org.
- **Training and Exercise:**
 - We are currently working with the SWAT, HazMat, and EOD working groups to develop Mid X 2018. Mid X will be setup as a morning workshop with a drill in the afternoon to address gaps identified in the Big X AAR-IP for integrated response. We are currently looking at February 2018 for the exercise and plan to do three one day iterations one in the North, East, and West.
 - The Rhodium Incident Management project is currently implementing Phase I of the roll out. Phase I includes 22 licenses: EST/OEM has 16, DDC Garland and DDC Hurst each have one, PWERT has two, and EGRT has two. Webinars for these licenses have been scheduled and will take place prior to the two day in depth training and build out sessions scheduled for April 17-18, 2017.
 - Phase II will focus on the region's emergency response specialties. This phase will also incorporate a series of webinars leading up to the in depth training scheduled for June 6-7, 2017.
 - The EOC Support Team (EST) member on-boarding training and team documentation have been finalized and the initial training is scheduled for April 24-25, 2017 at the Coppell EOC. The training announcement and registration link was sent out by Billy Owens, North Richland Hills OEM, if you are an EST member and did not receive the information and would

like to attend please email Billy Owens, bowens@nrhtx.com, or Tonda Henry, thenry@nctcog.org, for the information.

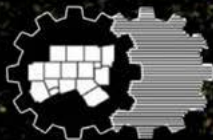
